The starting order of the second round was in reverse order of results in the first round and there was a jump off for medals (Gold/Silver & Silver/Bronze), if necessary. All four 3. The Mediterranean Games should have been held in 2017. Two different rounds were held and the second round had But for financial reasons, they were postponed till 2018. Also during the XVII Mediterranean Games that were held in Istanbul, equestrian showjumping competitions were cancelled for two reasons:

> The venue of the equestrian events (City of Adana) was considered to be in Asia. Veterinary conditions and movement of horses differ from Asia to Europe (the host city: Istanbul, being in Europe).

> Adana was 300 km away from Istanbul (Rule allows a radius of 100 km max, around the host city).

> The next Mediterranean Games will take place in Oran, Algeria 2021.
