The Dubai International Arabian Horse Championship is a competition for Purebred Arabian horses, showcasing their beauty, agility & heritage. It is run over 4 days culminating in the Championship classes for the most exquisite horses.

The Dubai International Arabian Horse Championship is the most prestigious competition of its kind in the world. It is a beauty competition for Purebred Arabian horses, from the very young to the elderly statesmen of the Arabian equine world.

Under the patronage of HH Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Deputy Ruler of Dubai, and UAE Minister of Finance & Industry, the championship will be run for the 3rd time in March 2006.

The 2005 event was a huge success with 248 horses entered from 11 countries and competing for prizes valued at US\$500,000. The Championship will now run over 4 days commencing at 4.30pm each day. It commences on Sunday the 26th of March 2006 concluding on Wednesday the 29th of March 2006.

The event will take place in the Dubai International Exhibition Centre in halls 7 & 8 and is open to the public.

Alongside the Championship, the Dubai International Horse Fair will take place for the second year. The Horse Fair will cater to everyone in the equestrian world from businessmen to consumers.
